The Middle St. Croix Watershed Management Organization (MSCWMO) is the governmental unit with primary responsibility for protecting the water resources of the Middle St. Croix watershed.

Minnesota Statute, Section 103B.277, Subdivision 5, requires the MSCWMO to solicit proposals every two years for consulting services. The MSCWMO currently contracts for legal and engineering services. The anticipated legal services provided to the district may include, but are not limited to; watershed plan amendments, joint powers agreements, WMO boundary changes, grant agreements, and advising on project funding options. The anticipated engineering services may include, but are not limited to: plant review, project feasibility, project design, and construction administration.
